Tasting Notes

Seductive scents of ripe Bing cherries, forest path and clove. Forward drinking and enticing with mid weight flavors of black cherry, blackberry, cola, spice and tobacco. Tannins are harmoniously supportive and the silky texture is tres Pinot. Always a crowd-pleaser. Simply Delicious.

Winemaking

Grapes were picked in the darkness of the early morning hours, and immediately subjected to rigorous hand sorting and refinement process. The whole berries were gently delivered to tank. Cold soaks lasted five to seven days, and fermentations were managed via a combination of delestage and pumpovers. Extended maceration ranging from three to four weeks fine-tuned our tannin profiles, allowing us to perfect mouth feel and wine complexity. The wine was aged 9 months in 100% French oak, 30% of which was new.

Vineyards

The fruit was sourced from a Sangiacomo Vineyard located in Southern Sonoma consisting of 100% Pommard Pinot Noir. Yields were maintained at lower levels for increased quality, ranging from 3.5 to 4 tons/acre.
