## Our Story

Our winemaking approach is simple; make exceptional wine from carefully selected artisan vineyards that express Sonoma Coast's unique character.

The name COSA OBRA is comprised of two words:

COSA meaning *"thing"* and  
OBRA meaning *"a hand-crafted body of work"*

So we say: *"This is our thing, this is what we do, our hand-crafted body of work"*
